The present buildings at 2124 7th Street and 615-621 22nd Avenue were constructed circa 1924 as common commercial building. The 1929 city directory lists the Foster Funeral Home and Funeral Fund at this location. James D. Foster, the company's president, treasurer, and general manager is listed in the 1930 census as a sixty-eight year-old undertaker who was born in Ohio. The funeral home is listed again in the 1935 city directory but had been replaced by Olan Mills Studio by the time the 1938 edition was compiled. Olan Mills Studio was founded in Selma, Alabama in 1932 by Olan Mills, Sr. and his wife Mary. They soon acquired a bankrupt photo studio in Tuscaloosa where they began processing photographic portraits. By 1940, the company was advertising that it was the "Nation's Studio Represented in 30 states."1 The company continued to be listed in this building through the 1950 city directory. It eventually grew to become the nation's largest portrait photography company.






